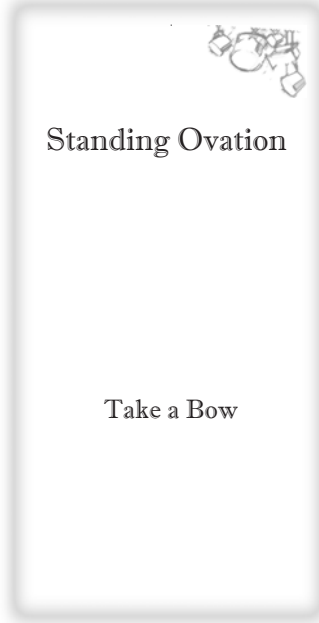
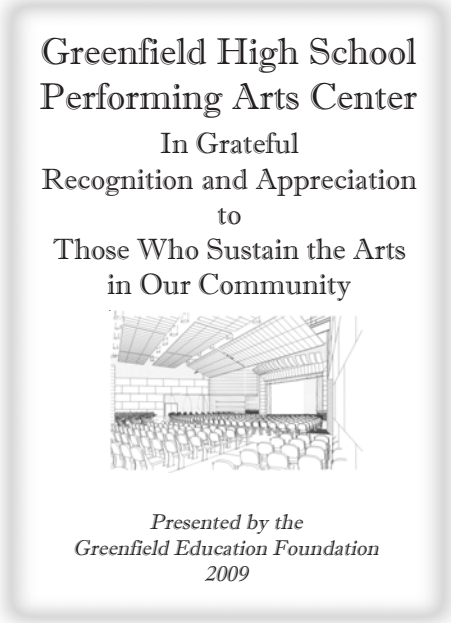


Support the Greenfield High School Performing Arts Center
